Achievement Awards / Volunteer Hours

July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2023 (Submit by May 2023)

Each one of you has contributed hours, on a volunteer basis, to our Republican cause. Attached is a simple tally sheet where you can write in those hours, for the two-year period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2023. It is often difficult to go back and recreate the past, but try to recall events you have supported, committees you have worked on, etc., and approximate when they occurred or keep track contemporaneously--daily, weekly or monthly. Estimate your time through June 30th. Use the attached form; a handwritten submittal is all that is required. Submit the Volunteer Hours form monthly at a club meeting or email directly to the GPRW Awards Chairman. All members – Active, Associate and CWAC Men's Auxiliary – count towards the combined club efforts!

These are the types of hours you can include in the GPRW, AzFRW and NFRW columns:

- All Club Meetings, events and activities including preparation for such and door-to-door travel.
- Committee work hours in meeting, preparing for meetings, working on committee projects, etc.
- Attendance at State and National Federation meetings and conventions; include door-to-door travel.
- Volunteering at any Republican or Federation Headquarters (local, county, State, National).
- Preparing an article for the Newsletter or an e-blast.
- Participation in any forum, including ZOOM, sponsored by the Federation or Republican Party

Many of you worked directly in support of electing Republicans to local, State and Federal offices during the two-year timeframe. **All of those hours should be entered in the <u>AZGOP, Legislative District (LD)</u> <u>and Campaign columns.</u> Just do your best to determine where your hours go. They will all roll up to the higher-level <u>Campaign Awards</u> tally. Examples of these hours are:**

- Non-paid campaign activities volunteering for a candidate, getting petitions signed.
- Work done at home on mailings, making posters, making phone calls, computer work, etc.
- Time in session and door-to-door travel to Arizona Republican Party Convention, Maricopa County Statutory Meeting and Republican National Committee Convention.
- Time spent as a Precinct Committeeman and Precinct Captain.
- Working as a non-paid Poll Watcher on Election Day.
- Letter-writing projects to legislators, news outlets, etc., including AZ Request To Speak system.
